- Am I willing to help a newcomer go to any lengths – his lengths, not mine – to stay sober?

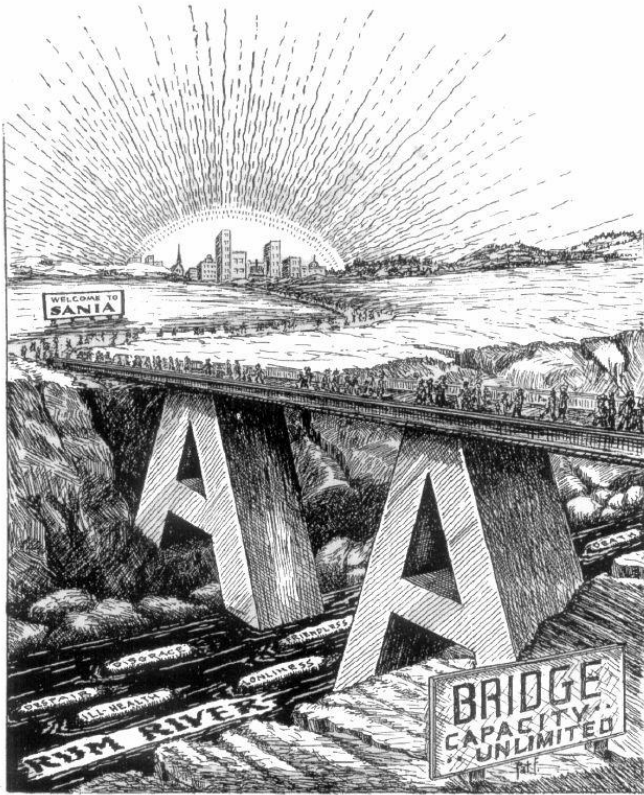

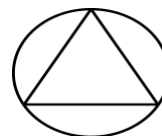
From The Grapevine's "At Wit's End":
