Open Meetings - All are welcome.

Closed Meetings: These meetings are specifically for AA members: the only requirement for AA membership is a desire to stop drinking.

Big Book Study Meetings: We read and study the Big Book and typically discuss topics related to the reading.

Topic Meetings: Typically someone chooses a topic or a reading to share.

Speaker Meetings: A speaker shares their story and that is the focus of the meeting.

Step/Tradition Study: These meetings involve studying the 12 steps of AA or the 12 Traditions in more depth.
