- Planning special events to build unity and enjoy our sobriety

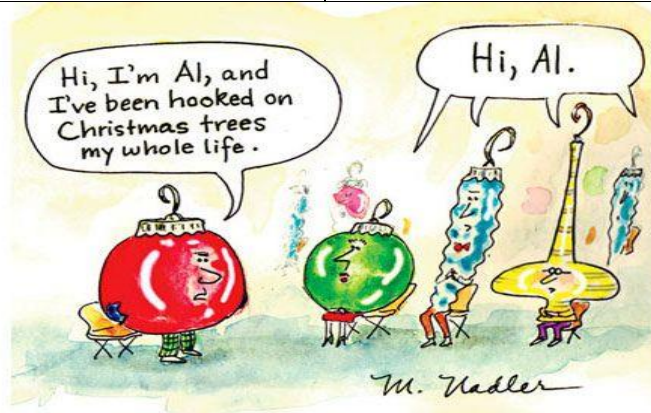

Tradition 12: Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all our traditions, ever reminding us to place principles before personalities

Concept 12: The Conference shall observe the spirit of A.A. tradition, taking care that it never becomes the seat of perilous wealth or power; that sufficient operating funds and reserve be its prudent financial principle; that it place none of its members in a position of unqualified authority over others; that it reach all important decisions by discussion, vote, and whenever possible, by substantial unanimity; that its actions never be personally punitive nor an incitement to public controversy; that it never perform acts of government, and that, like the Society it serves, it will always remain democratic in thought and action



Drinking And Driving

States with more restrictive alcohol policies and regulations have lower rates of self-reported drunk driving, according to a new study. A surprising finding of the study was that laws intended to prevent binge drinking - such as high alcohol taxes, safe serving laws, and retail sales restrictions - were equally as protective against drunk driving as were laws specifically targeting impaired driving, such as sobriety checkpoints. Dr. Timothy Naimi, the study's senior author, said that while states have done a lot to prevent impaired people from driving, "we haven't done enough to prevent people from getting drunk in the first place. 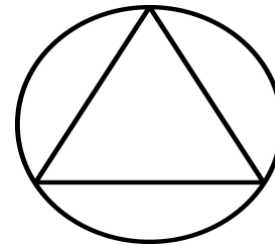
